2017 AALL New Member Annual Conference Grant

Grant Information:

- One grant will be awarded this year to a new member of both LLAGNY and AALL in need of assistance to attend the AALL 110th Annual Meeting and Conference in Austin, Texas.
- The grant is funded by AALL in order to provide an opportunity for a newer member to attend an annual meeting and have an enriching and valuable experience as the member learns and networks with colleagues from across the country.
- This grant covers only the cost of registration for the conference. It does not cover the cost of travel and hotel expenses.
- The deadline for all applications is 5:00 pm on March 15th, 2017. Applications should be sent to grantsandscholarships@llagny.org.
- Grant recipients will be notified no later than Monday, March 20, 2017. LLAGNY must notify AALL of the acceptance of the grant by the recipient by April 1, 2017. As such, the award recipient must respond to accept the grant as soon as possible after being notified that they have been awarded the grant.
- Proof of registration for the Annual Conference must be submitted to the Committee Chair no later than 30 days after the recipient receives the grant funds to be in compliance with the grant.
- Recipients will be required to write a Law Lines article on the AALL Conference.
- Recipients will be honored at the June Dinner and Annual Meeting and are expected to attend as guests of LLAGNY.

Grant Criteria:

1. Applicant must be a Regular or Student LLAGNY member and also be a Student or Active member of AALL. To be considered a new member, the applicant should have five years or less of membership in AALL and five years or less of membership in LLAGNY.
2. Applicants must have demonstrated a commitment to librarianship, based on employment history, membership in AALL, involvement in LLAGNY and/or AALL, and attendance at LLAGNY functions. The selected applicant will also demonstrate how they intend to participate in her or his professional association, both locally and nationally, as their career develops in the future.
3. More weight will be given to those who do not receive employment contributions or matching funds.
4. More weight will be given to whether or not the applicant has previously attended an AALL Annual Meeting.
5. Previous grant and scholarship recipients are eligible to apply. Although consideration will be given to whether or not the applicant has previously received a LLAGNY grant or scholarship, it will not preclude an applicant from receiving this grant.

We will begin accepting applications on March 1, 2017.
